## PASTOR'S ARTICLE

One of the great encouragements during the pandemic has been our church's faithfulness in giving. Many of you discovered how to give through online giving, or using our bank draft option. Many of you have mailed in your tithes and offerings while others make sure that it arrives at church during our worship time or another time during our week. Because you have been so faithful, our Finance Committee has been able to develop a budget plan for 2022 with confidence. You should have received a copy of the proposed budget in the mail by now and we will begin the approving process over the next few weeks.

Let me remind you how we devise our budget each year. The Finance Committee begins with contacting various ministries and committees within the church and asking for their input in regards to the budget. These ministries and committees make a formal proposal to the Finance Committee, outlining their needs for the coming year. In addition, our Administrative Committees also make requests. The Finance Committee also reviews the church's needs in regards to utilities and other reoccurring costs. After all of the requests are made and other items reviewed, the Finance Committee creates a proposed budget. This budget is presented to the Trustees of our church for questions and information. The budget is then mailed to all church members.

All of this part of the process has been completed. The next steps occur on October 17, 2021 and October 24, 2021. During our regular Church Conference on October 17 at 7:00 p.m. in the Sanctuary, the Finance Committee will review the budget and answer any questions about the proposed budget. If there are no amendments offered at this meeting, the budget will be voted on at the end of worship at both services on October 24, 2021. If there is an amendment offered on the 17th, the church will reconvene for discussion on the amendment on the evening of October 24th and the final vote will occur on October 31 at the end of worship.

I am so grateful for those who make this process occur each year and for all who are good stewards of the gifts and tithes we give to God. I pray that you will continue to be faithful in giving and discover the joy of joining what God is doing in us and through us at Trinity.

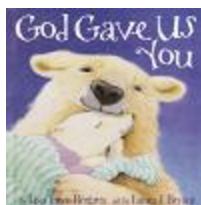

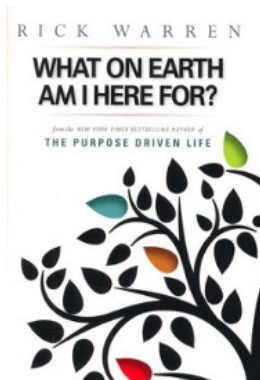

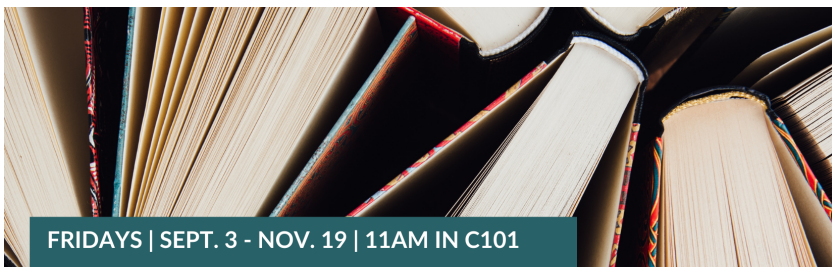
