In Romans 12:6-8, the Apostle Paul writes:

I ask that you remember to mail or return your ballot and participate in this process. Please pray for those listed on the ballots and thank them for being willing to serve.

In addition, we approved our 2022 Budget this past Sunday and our Finance Committee did an excellent job in preparing our budget for the coming year. This process the past two years has had several challenges. However, the faithfulness of our congregation in giving and the dedication of our Finance Committee and Financial Officers have helped us be faithful to our Mission Partners and has placed us in excellent financial shape as a congregation.

As we are grateful for these who are using their gifts let us also be willing to serve, as we are able to the glory of God.

REALM

Exciting news! Trinity has migrated to a new online database!

We need everyone to sign in to their personal Realm Account to use the new robust database. This will give us an online directory of everyone that has signed up on the Realm directory plus the ability to search for church members. This updated program also gives us new abilities such as taking roll for Sunday School directly from the Realm app and group messaging. Please sign up for Realm so we can correspond with all of you!

Using Realm for marking attendance, for those who are designated by their class. There are two ways: :

- 1. Use the downloaded app: RealmConnect
 - Go to bottom of page and click events. By 9:30am each Sunday, a Sunday School attendance event should show for your SS class and you can mark attendance here.
- 2. Go to **onrealm.org** or accept the invitation sent to you previously.
 - All members have been sent an invitation. Sign in. In Tasks, choose Admin, then groups. Choose your group, then select events for marking SS attendance.


