

- Daily Devotional Cards are provided in the Narthex for each family or member to pick up. These Devotional cards provide a thought for the day on one side and a prayer on the other. Keep them close by your bed or near your desk or kitchen for a quick devotion and prayer throughout the season. May it encourage you to become Full to the Brim of God's amazing grace.
- 2. **Daily Devotional booklets**: "The Sanctuary for Lent" A longer read for each day with scripture and a message for inspiration and encouragement.
- 3. **Labyrinth**: A labyrinth is a spiritual tool or floor pattern to walk through as one prays or meditates.
 - a. We have a labyrinth that will be in C101 classroom beginning on Monday March 21.
 - b. We will have a larger Labyrinth set on the floor of the Fellowship Hall from March 24- April 3.
 - c. We can also use the garden labyrinth on the north side of Hudson Memorial any time during Lent. It is lighted at night as well.
- 4. Pilgrimage Tapestry: As we travel on the Journey to Jerusalem, we are reminded of how our life changes by unraveling and being woven back together. As a pilgrim on the journey please take a strip of cloth and write a prayer or pray a prayer or praise over it. Then lay the cloth back on the table to be woven into a tapestry medallion.
