

Door of Hope in South Africa OCTOBER 13-25, 2022 | \$500

Through our partnership with Baptists on Mission, our Trinity Team will have the opportunity to help build small cottages that will house an average of 6 children along with a host couple. Cottages will be made of interlocking cement blocks that will be made on site and then stacked to build the cottages. The process is quite simple and does not require skilled labor. We will have the opportunity to worship with and encourage local churches, and we will discover that the encouragement and the missions effort certainly goes both ways.

Since 1999, Door of Hope has rescued over 1750 abandoned infants with the goal of providing them a temporary Christian home while seeking long term foster care or permanent homes for each one. There are many older children not chosen for adoption who need a long term home, and that is where these cottages and foster parents come in.

HEALING HANDS OF FAITH MINISTRY

Healing Hands of Faith (HHF) consists of caring believers from Trinity Baptist Church, joining hands with God, to minister to the holistic health needs of the faith community, focusing on the intentional care of the spirit.

HHF health ministers will assist church members, and non-members, transition through multiple stages of healthcare by acting as liaisons and integrators of faith and health. Our mission of holistic healthcare for our congregation will be accomplished through HHF health ministers working as:

- Health advocates—providing non-invasive health care such as blood pressure and heart rate checks, physical assessments, as well as aiding in understanding and effectively using health care and social service systems.
- 2. **Health educators**—through individual and group education on health promotion and disease prevention.
- Health counselors—assisting with visitation and follow-up in homes, hospitals, and long-term facilities.

- Referral advisors—referring individuals to a pastor, a physician, or community services as needed.
- Health liaisons acting as a gobetween for the congregation and community resources, as well as making our ministers aware of needs.
- 6. And faith and health integrators—seeking to promote understanding of the relationship between faith and health by providing spiritual care and guidance around health issues.

WAYS TO PRAY FOR VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL 2022

Pray for open hearts.

In Matthew 13, Jesus shares the story of a farmer scattering seeds. The seeds that fell on good soil thrived, producing a harvest beyond the farmer's wildest dreams! Ask God to begin preparing kids' hearts, softening them and opening them to take in the "seeds" of God's Word.



Pray for relationships.

When VBS kids build friendships with other kids and loving adults, it creates an open door for them to begin or deepen their friendship with Jesus. Go through your registration list and "pray" the name of each child, asking God to bring a special, surprising friendship into that child's life during VBS.



Thank God for families.

Parents or caregivers are usually the ones who get kids in the door of your program. They've signed kids un and will likely be bringing them each day Thank God for sending each family your way! Thank God for parents. grandparents, or even babysitters who love him and want kids to know and love him, too



Pray for wise staff members.

Crew Leaders or small group leaders hear a lot about what kids are going through, what's on their minds, how they're struggling, and what worries they have. Ask God to pour his wisdom into your leaders as they interact with kids, giving them the right words and actions to reflect the heart of God.



Listen.

Spend several minutes in silence, listening for the plans God has for your VBS. His plans may be a little different from yours! Maybe you want huge numbers...but God just wants a certain person to be there. You may have visions of everything running perfectly... but God is going to do amazing things through "imperfect" circumstances, Rest in God's hands, and give your program to him.
