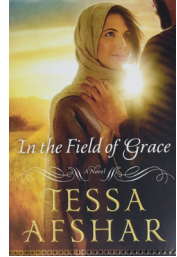

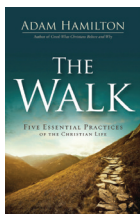

## SIX MONTHS IN MISSIONS AT TRINITY

*"My family joined Trinity because of the missions-mindedness of the congregation."*

Over the years, John and his family have enjoyed missions involvement through student missions and by connecting with Raleigh Rescue Mission cook-outs through their adult Sunday School class. John has lent his giftedness in construction and grilling in service to God by helping to make our missions events possible. His heart for God has been evident as he has led our students on mission trips using both his professional knowledge and his faith in Christ.

Yet, John's story on the missions steering committee is all too familiar. Most folks who join this committee after accepting nomination from the church find that they only knew a small piece of the giant missions puzzle. It's a common refrain, "I didn't realize all that was happening until I joined this committee." Followed by another refrain, "We have got to do a better job of making sure the congregation knows." We want to make sure that you all know all that God is doing through your church and all that you are invited to do with God by joining Him in missions through Trinity.

What follows is an overview of what has happened through Trinity in the first six months of 2022:

*Lead Team Conference - Just under 300 participants joined in-person and virtually*

*through Facebook Live to learn about the 15 active missions lead teams at Trinity*

*\$47,000 was sent to Ukraine Relief through Baptists on Mission and the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship*

*\$71,664.16 was sent to Global Missions supporting career missionaries through the International Missions Board and the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship*

*\$25,720 was sent to Home Missions supporting career missionaries through the North American Missions Board and the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship*

*\$24,129.16 to our Cooperative Missions Partners - CBF, CBFNC, SBC, NCBSC, and Raleigh Baptist Association*

*A missions partner covenant has been drafted and will be established between Trinity Baptist Church and her sister congregation, Raleigh Arabic Baptist Church*

*\$8,250 to support the ministries of Raleigh Arabic Baptist Church*

*Through our partnership with Habitat for Humanity of Wake County's Faith Coalition, we have supported the building of eight townhomes both financially and with our own manual labor.*

*Hosting Disaster Relief Training March 4-5 for over 300 baptists from across the state to be trained to respond in the event of a disaster.*

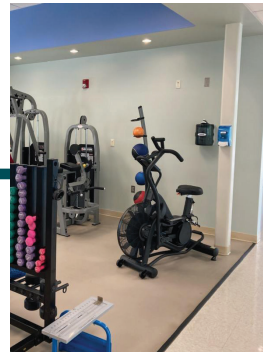
