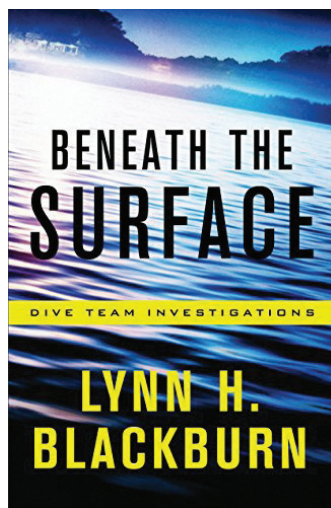

## RALEIGH ARABIC BAPTIST CHURCH

In 1984, the North Carolina Baptist State Convention and the Raleigh Baptist Association discerned the call to plant a Baptist church for Arabic-speaking Christians in the Raleigh area. RABC began meeting in homes and was led by Rev. Bill and Nancy Hern. For the past 36 years, Trinity has played host to this vibrant worshipping congregation. In 1986, Rev. Charles Farag and his wife, Susan, were called to lead the church. Rev. Farag began an outreach program by writing to all persons bearing an Arabic name in the Raleigh phone book. Rev. Farag also enrolled at Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary where he received a Master of Divinity degree in December of 1989.

Approximately 1988, Rev. Farag began airing a television ministry entitled, "Prophet or God," to reach Muslims with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. This ministry continued to air for 12 years. The door has recently opened to begin a new television program to the Arabic population around the world. This new program, "How to Be Like Jesus" will be aired via the satellite of the "Aramia" and other Arabic networks.

Rev. Farag has faithfully served and led this congregation in faith development, evangelism, and missions. Over the years, Trinity has enjoyed fellowship with RABC as her members joined in Sunday School, Vacation Bible School, Fall Fest, Recreation Activities, and

Fellowship Events.

Each week RABC meets for Bible Study, Choir Practice, Sunday School, and Worship. As a church, they enjoy annual conferences with other language specific churches through the NCBSC and revivals held here in our chapel (their worship space). Just this month, RABC hosted an evangelism event and potluck for Arabic-speaking people throughout the Triangle area where the Gospel message was presented and fellowship was shared with non-believers.

We are grateful for the faithfulness and leadership provided by Rev. Farag and his church leaders, Gemy and Norah Gaid, Linda Rafidi, Kamal Rizk, and many others. In 2021-2022, Trinity's RABC Nurturing Team has been hard at work as we seek to strengthen our churches' fellowship with one another as well as our missional and evangelistic outreach. We are looking forward to celebrating this renewed commitment together on September 25, 2022 with a joint potluck fellowship and covenant service from 12:15p.m.-12:45p.m. in the fellowship hall. We hope you will put this very special event on your calendar and plan to bring a dish to share!

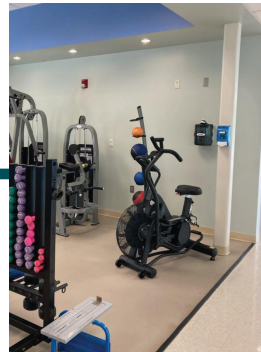
