COMMUNITY PROJECTS:

Rise Against Hunger is an international hunger relief non-profit organization that coordinates the packaging and distribution of food and other aid to people in developing nations. We will need 40/50 volunteers at each location to help package food.

Note in the Pocket is a non-profit organization that provides quality clothing to homeless and impoverished children and families with dignity and love. We will be collecting new and very gently used clothing for children. Volunteers will be needed at each site to help sort the clothing and prepare it to be delivered to Note in the Pocket.

Adult Curriculum and Rosters Ready for Fall

Welcome House provides a hospitality ministry to our vulnerable neighbors across the state, including Afghans and Ukrainians. We will be collecting and sorting household goods such as paper products, cleaning supplies, towels, sheets, etc. to be used by those served by the Welcome House.

Raleigh Baptist Association State Fair Ministry along with the Campers on Mission provides daily meals, hygiene items and ministers to the carnival workers during their stay at the NC State Fair. We will be collecting the following

food and hygiene items at each site. We will need volunteers at each site to sort and box these items.

<u>State Fair Food Items</u>: Canned Potatoes, Sweet Sue Brand Chicken & Dumplings; Cream of Potato Soup, Cream of Celery Soup, Baked Beans, Canned Mixed vegetables, Chili and Beans, Canned Chicken, Lima Beans, Corn, Black Beans, Southwestern Chicken Tortilla Soup, Creamy Peanut Butter and Grape Jam, Beef Stew (Dinty Moore, Great Value or Armour only).

<u>Hygiene Items</u>: Trial size only Toothpaste, Toothbrush (Regular size), Shampoo, Hair Conditioner, Deodorant, Soap, Disposable Razors, Wash Cloths, Combs (no brush), New Ball Point Pens, Pocket Size Note Pads, Gallon Size Zip Lock Bags.

Habitat for Humanity is a Christian organization that seeks to put God's love into action by helping build affordable housing. We will have the opportunity to help build on this day. This will be an off site project that will run from 8:15a.m. to 3:30p.m.

ALWAYS A PLACE FOR YOU! Find your place in the music ministry! If you have singing or instrumental abilities, we need you. We can experience the blessings we receive from music year after year due to our the mind's recalling of familiar words that tell us Jesus loves us and that He will never let us go through life without His presence with us.

For the sake of today's church and of tomorrow's worshippers, music and song must continue to help share the messages of hope and salvation with all who hear. We need singers and instrumentalists to carry on the calling we have to make His praise glorious (Psalm 66:2) with psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit (Col. 3:16). The choir experience is a great place where we lead other worshippers in the worship of Christ and grow in the faith. You are welcome to come join a choir and experience first-hand the love of the Lord and the music we offer Him!

Our Fall program will be restarting for Wednesday nights on September 7. I'm getting excited about our "Midweek in Midtown" theme for Wednesday activities! Our children's choirs and ensembles will begin their preparation for worship and seasonal offerings. Parents, begin planning for children's choirs now! 


