This coming Sunday night, October 16, our Finance Committee will present the proposed budget for 2023. If you are a member, you should have received a copy of the budget in the mail in the past few weeks. The process for our budget proposal begins at the beginning of the summer of each year. Our committees, ministers and program leaders begin the process of assessing their needs to fund our various ministries. Over the summer requests are submitted to our Finance Committee who have the responsibility of developing a budget for the coming year. Each year. these faithful church members consider the various requests and form a budget that not only funds our ministries and programs but makes sure our commitment to missions is maintained. They also closely monitor our giving patterns and our financial health. The Finance Committee then develops a comprehensive budget proposal that is reasonable and at the same time is a faith step for our congregation. The Finance Committee then presents this proposal to our Trustees who review the budget and make any suggestions to our Finance Committee. Finally, our Finance Committee presents our budget in October Church Conference and if there are no amendments, we vote as a congregation on the following Sunday at the end of worship in a special called Church Conference. I hope you have reviewed our budget proposal and of course you can be a part of any discussion at Church Conference on October 16, 2022, at 7:00 p.m. in the Sanctuary.

I am grateful for all who are a part of this process each year and thankful to all who support our budget through giving to our church. I am always reminded that our budget is a complete "faith" budget. It is a faith budget because every dollar we receive as a congregation is from those who voluntarily choose to be obedient to the Bible's instruction to tithe and present our offerings to God. It is a faith budget because we believe by faith our offerings are going to make a difference in the Kingdom of God. Through our generous giving, we can not only offer ministries to all in our congregation but also to our community and to others around the world. You are making a difference when you give.

So, as we come to this time of decision every year, I am reminded that this is not simply an administrative matter but a commitment to having sacred spaces where God's people can gather for worship and Bible study to make disciples. It is a commitment to providing spaces and ministries to people in our community. It is a commitment to the next



TBC LIBRARY NEWS LINE OF DUTY SERIES



Janice Cantore, a retired Long Beach California police officer of 22 years, tells us about the perils of Tess O'Rourke in the Line of Duty series.

Tess O'Rourke dreams of becoming the first female chief of police in Long Beach, California. As commander of the East Division, she is well on her way . . . until the night she responds to an officer-needs-assistance call and fatally shoots an unarmed teenager. Despite being cleared of wrongdoing by a grand jury, Tess is so hounded by the public that she takes

a job in Oregon to escape the bad press. Winning over the residents of Rogue's Hollow might be more difficult than adjusting to her new role as police chief in the small, backwater town. Especially when her closest friend, the pastor's wife, goes missing and the woman's cousin is found shot. Tess finds an ally in sheriff's deputy Steve Logan, but as they track down Rogue's Hollow's first murderer, she worries that she's breaking one of her rules and getting too close to him.

All three books in the series, <u>Crisis Shot</u>, <u>Lethal Target</u>, and <u>Cold Aim</u>, are available on the shelf in the TBC Library and are also available as eBooks in the TBC Digital Library.

HEALING HANDS OF FAITH MINISTRY

Over the past year, several of our church's nurses have been meeting, learning, and praying about building a ministry to our church community that will provide an extra level of care during the health transitions that we will all inevitably face. Out of these meetings, Healing Hands of Faith (HHF) Ministry was born. In short, these volunteers are here to make "spiritual visits with medical eyes" when you or your loved one faces changes in health status and level of care.

HHF consists of caring believers from Trinity Baptist Church, joining hands with God, to minister to the holistic health needs of the faith community, focusing on the intentional care of the spirit.

HHF health ministers will assist church members, and non-members, transition through multiple stages of healthcare by acting as liaisons and integrators of faith and health.

Our mission of holistic healthcare for our congregation will be accomplished through HHF health ministers working as:

- 1. **Health advocates**—providing non-invasive health care such as blood pressure and heart rate checks, physical assessments, as well as aiding in understanding and effectively using health care and social service systems.
- 2. **Health educators**—through individual and group education on health promotion and disease prevention.
- 3. **Health counselors**—assisting with visitation and follow-up in homes, hospitals, and long-term facilities.
- 4. **Referral advisors**—referring individuals to a pastor, a physician, or community services as needed.
- 5. **Health liaisons**...acting as a go-between for the congregation and community resources, as well as making our ministers aware of needs.
- 6. And **faith and health integrators** seeking to promote understanding of the relationship between faith and health by providing spiritual care and guidance around health issues.


