Dear Church Family,

I am writing to inform you that Rev. Christian Davis is going to be leaving us at the end of the year to become the Minister of Engagement at First Baptist Church in Wilmington, N.C. State to explore his calling and be an intern in our Student Ministry. We could not have imagined then what God had planned. We are planning an "after church reception" in their honor following our 10:55 a.m. service. Christian's last Sunday will be the 11th but he will still be in the office and working with us until the end of the year.

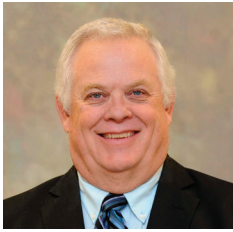


