In the liturgical church year there are many seasons and days of celebration. At Trinity, we particularly observe the seasons of Advent and Lent as a way of preparing for Christmas and Easter. In the liturgical year there is also what is referred to as “ordinary time.” Ordinary time is just what it sounds like... ordinary. Ordinary time is the time between the great seasons of the church year. As you would expect, most of the church year is ordinary time. Just like it is for all of us. When we pause to reflect on our lives, we realize that most of life is spent in the ordinary days. We of course have great moments of celebration. We have our times away from the routine and experiences where we make memories, but most of life is spent on the way to the office, at our job, sitting in carpool, in the classroom, shopping for groceries, cleaning the house, watching children play a sport or just quiet moments at home with family and friends. Most of life is not spectacular no matter what social media suggests life is like.

At church we find ourselves between the great celebration of Advent and Christmas and preparing for the observance of Lent and celebration of Easter. In between these times is the ordinary of church life. We join to worship and study the Bible. We fellowship with one another, and we teach our children the importance of faith in word and deed. We organize our congregation for the coming year so we can serve Christ and one another effectively. That is January and February. It is ordinary time.

I am reminded that God’s most important work may be done in our ordinary time. It is the daily discipline of prayer and reading the Bible, that prepares us for moments of celebration and challenge. So, if Winter is more ordinary than extraordinary for you, remember God is with you and at work in the most ordinary day.

I was recently given a beautiful book by one of my co-workers, Julie Williams. The book is entitled “Every Moment Holy.” It is a book that is filled with litanies and prayers for everyday occurrences. The book begins with a quote from Wendell Berry and these words in the Forward:

*“There are no unsacred places; there are only sacred places and desecrated places.”-Wendell Berry. “In that spirit, there are no unsacred moments. There are only sacred moments and moments we have forgotten are sacred. If this is true, then it is our duty to reclaim the sacredness of our lives and life itself.”*

Let us give thanks to God for ordinary time.
