Belong. Become. Be.

In just a week we will begin the Season of Lent. If you were like me, you did not observe Lent in your Baptist church growing up. However, there are many Baptist congregations where Lent as well as other seasons of the church year have always been observed and celebrated. The first church I served where Lent was a part of their normal seasonal calendar was at First Baptist Church of Middlesboro Kentucky. The whole season was new to me. I had to educate myself on not only practices of my new congregation but also the practices of the larger church and the importance of this season. Over the years, this became my favorite season in the church year. I found the emphasis of Lent leading to the cross and resurrection to be of utmost importance in my own faith walk as a follower of Jesus. I discovered the depth of spending time in reflection on my own sins, my need of forgiveness and the grace I had received to be transformative. I also found myself ready to observe Holy Week and especially Easter with a whole new preparation and attitude.

When I became your Pastor in 2000 we began to observe the Season of Lent. It was a newer celebration to some but for many it was rediscovering of an important tradition in their own lives from former congregations and traditions. Over the past few years, we have begun observing Ash Wednesday together as a way of beginning this season. Ash Wednesday is the traditional beginning of the Season of Lent. The ancient practice of having ashes imposed on one's forehead or wrist is a reminder of our mortality, the need of forgiveness and the promise of eternity through Christ Jesus. As we Baptist tend to do, we have adapted some of the ancient practices to fit our own theology and practices over the years. (This is one of the great parts of being a Baptist and part of a local Baptist church.) Our Ash Wednesday experience is one of those adapted practices.

This year we will observe Ash Wednesday on February 22. The evening will begin with our monthly fellowship meal. We will begin at 5:00 p.m. and the service will be at 6:15 p.m. in the Sanctuary. Please make sure you register for the meal so we can have a good count for preparation. You can find that QR code in this newsletter or you can go to the website or call the church office.
