Belong. Become. Be.

As I write this article, I am sitting on a balcony in modern Jerusalem looking over this beautiful city. We are coming to the end of our tour of Israel, and we ended the day at the Garden Tomb and shared in communion. As we prepared for communion, I reminded our pilgrims that there were some important things to consider. First, it is the empty tomb and only the empty tomb that truly draws the follower of Jesus to Jerusalem. Without the empty tomb, Jerusalem would be a religious city about other people but not us. However, we were once not a people at all but now in Christ we are the people of God. I also reminded our group that Jesus' sacrifice on the cross was for all people for all time. It was a sacrifice once and once and for all. We have learned much through the week about the sacrifices at the Temple and the Torah and the laws of Judaism. However, in Christ we are free from the law and live by grace. We have been set free by Jesus who is both the sacrifice and the high priest for us. Our Forgiveness in Christ is full and complete. As we were walking through the Garden Tomb, the Muslim call for prayer could be heard throughout the city. I reminded us that when I heard that call, I just remembered that there is only one who has gone to the grave and risen from the dead. Our Lord lives! We serve a living Savior.

Finally, as we were taking communion it was noted that the Garden Tomb is next to a busy bus station. The buses were busily coming in and out of the station. People were hustling and bustling about their busy everyday lives. Just as when Jesus was crucified, people walked by, and thousands filled the streets of Jerusalem for Passover never knowing what God was doing on a hill outside the city. So, it is now, we can miss the significance of the empty tomb with the busyness of life.

As we took the bread and cup we remembered. We remembered Jesus' life, his words, commands, ways and death and resurrection. Like those who were first at the empty tomb we walked away amazed at what God was doing in this world.

It seems that this is a good word for all for us as we enter this observance of Lent. It is good for us on this journey to the cross to remember Jesus is the one who has called us to himself. It is right for us to remember the Lord's death until he comes again. It is empowering to know we serve a living Lord. Lent is a good time to slow down and recall what God has done in Christ. I pray this Lenten Season you will spend time wondering

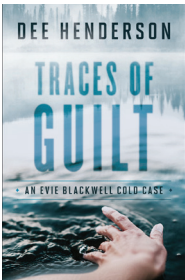
