Dear Trinity Family,

It is with regret that I am writing to inform you that our Associate Pastor and Minister to Students, Rev. Claudia Grainger-Sink, has submitted her resignation effective July 23. I am grateful for Claudia's hard work and effort during this past year. The past year of transition for our Student Ministry created a great challenge and Claudia has served faithfully. Claudia will fulfill her commitment to lead our Senior trip and our High School mission trip before her resignation is effective. I know you will want to reach out to her and thank her for her ministry with us. Please keep her and her husband Tyler in your prayers during this transition. Claudia is very gifted, and I know God has much in store for her. In the next few weeks, there will be cards in the Narthex for you to use to write a word of encouragement to Claudia and thank her for her ministry with us.

I know that many may wonder about our next steps during this interim period. I have met with our Personnel Committee and Student Ministry Committee to put in place a plan for the next few months. We will ask our student intern Drew Langdon, who is a divinity school student at Campbell University, to serve as a part-time interim for Student Ministry. Drew's relationship with our students and a familiar presence will be essential in this interim period. However, we are all aware that our Student Ministry is a large responsibility and Drew will need our support and help during this period. In addition to Drew's responsibilities, our Student Ministry Committee will continue to work and serve our students. We are also very blessed to have so many dedicated volunteers who make a difference in the lives of our students each week.

We have asked Dr. Andy Jung to serve as the minister liaison to the Student Ministry Committee and he will meet with the committee and Drew to give guidance and leadership through this transition. Rev. Brooks Warren, will also be working with Drew and our leaders during weekly activities. We are blessed to have so many faithful members and volunteers who will help us as we go through this interim process.

Our Personnel Committee will begin work on reviewing our job description and also creating a search team for this important position. We will share more about this process in the weeks ahead.

The last thing Search and Rescue helicopter pilot Kacey Fairing needs upon returning home to Mercy Falls, Montana, is to run into her mistakes. After a devastating crash during her recent military tour in Afghanistan, she is emotionally broken but ready to start putting her life back together. She just wants to reconnect with her teenage daughter and spend the summer working as the new lead pilot of PEAK Rescue in Glacier National Park, But her mistakes aren't so easily forgotten. Because Ben King is also back in town. Country music star Ben King abandoned his past when he moved to Nashville thirteen years ago to start his career. He hoped to heal his broken heart, caused by losing the woman he loved. But when his father is injured, Ben is called home to help manage PEAK Rescue during his recovery. He doesn't realize his father has ulterior motives until his old flame. Kacev. walks into his house and back into his heart. Now, with Mercy Falls in a state of emergency due to flash floods, Kacey and Ben will have to work together to save lives. But when secrets are uncovered and old hurts rise to the surface, will they walk away again? Or can they find a different ending to their country love song?




