I love the way Eugene Peterson translates these few verses. We are reminded that Jesus is the reminder that God keeps God's promises and when we say yes to Jesus then God joins our yes to God's yes in Jesus and gives us the promise of life with God now and forever. That is worthy of an AMEN!

First, I will be preaching on the theme each week. This fall we will be exploring Bible characters and their stories of saying yes. In addition, our TNT studies on Tuesday and Wednesday will be a Bible Study on the same texts from the previous study. I have written these lessons for our study which will give us an opportunity to go deeper each week. In addition, Rev. Tatum has written a weekly devotion book that will be available to you for use in your daily devotions. In these ways and others, we will be making this journey together this fall.

What does it mean for us to say yes to Jesus? What does it mean for our church to say yes to God's future? What promises of God can we realize today by saying yes? Join us as we make this journey together.

It is 1704 when Genevieve Gaillain and her sister board a French ship headed for the Louisiana colony as mail-order brides. Both have promised to marry one of the rough-and-tumble Canadian men in this New World in order to escape religious persecution in the Old World. Genevieve knows life won't be easy, but at least here she can establish a home and family without fear of beheading. But when she falls in love with Tristan Lanier, an expatriate cartographer whose courageous stand for fair treatment

of native peoples has made him decidedly unpopular in the young colony, Genevieve realizes that even in this land of liberty one is not guaranteed peace. And a secret she harbors could mean the undoing of the colony itself. Gulf Coast native Beth White brings vividly to life the hot, sultry south in this luscious, layered story of the lengths we must go to in order to be true to ourselves, our faith, and our deepest loves.


