In 1994, the global Christian organization “Focus on the Family” started what is known today as Clergy or Pastor Appreciation Month, which is celebrated in October. Clergy or Pastor Appreciation Sunday is the second Sunday in October and in 2023, this is October 8. The idea of Clergy or Pastor Appreciation Month and Day is to recognize our ministers and let them know they are appreciated. Some say that the concept of Clergy or Pastor Appreciation began with the Apostle Paul, as he was establishing the first Christian churches. In 1 Timothy 5:17, we read: “The elders who direct the affairs of the church well are worthy of double honor, especially those whose work is preaching and teaching.”

In honor of Clergy or Pastor Appreciation Month, cards will be available in the Narthex during the month of October, allowing church members to write a personal note of encouragement or thanks to each of our pastors. See below for additional ways to show your love and support to our pastors.

- Give a gift card to pastor(s)' favorite restaurant, grocery store, entertainment venue.

- Create a special piece of art inspired by some sermon or other church function.
- Invite your pastor(s) to join you for a sporting or cultural event.
- Invite your pastor(s) to share a home cooked meal.
- Express a heartfelt: “thank you” for our pastors' accomplishments.

We are excited about the direction of this position and how it can add to our ministry and outreach.

I am grateful to our Personnel committee and their leadership in hiring staff and supporting our support staff and ministers.

I also want to remind you that our Finance Committee will be presenting our 2024 Church Budget in Church Conference on October 15 at 7:00 p.m. You are invited to attend this conference and ask any questions you might have regarding the budget. If there are no amendments that evening, we will vote to approve the budget at the end of worship on October 22. Thank you to all who are part of this process. Your input and vision are of great value as we seek to be good stewards of the financial resources God has placed in our hands.
