Faithful Intergenerational Apprenticeship By: Dr. Andy Jung

Over the years, I've been fascinated with generational studies. Though generational studies have to be used carefully to not put everyone in the generation in the same box or to place unhelpful labels on a group of people, it can shed light on general understanding of our culture and trends to look for in the future.

I have a deep passion for our younger generations and what is important to them in faith development. As many of you know, my full-time job is with Fuller Youth Institute (FYI) as the senior director for church engagement and business operations. At FYI, our mission is to equip diverse leaders and parents so faithful young people can change our world. I believe in our mission wholeheartedly. I believe our young people will change the world for good and help bring God's kingdom on earth as it is in heaven. (When I say "young people," I'm referring to teenagers and young adults who are Millennials (1980-1994), Gen Z (1995-2012). In case you were wondering, our children born after 2013 are known as Gen Alpha.)

Yet, as much as I believe in our young people, I also believe in those of us who are in the older generations (Gen X (1965-1979), Boomers (1946-1964), and Silent (1925-1945) generations). We desire the best for our children and grandchildren. We want them to know Jesus, love Jesus, and serve Jesus everyday. (Everyday YES to Jesus!) Sometimes, we just have a hard time understanding the younger generations and connecting with them in meaningful ways.

I've titled my column "Faithful Intergenerational Apprenticeship" because that is the vision I have for the Church and for Trinity Baptist. Healthy and thriving churches have healthy intergenerational relationships as their DNA. Most churches are multigenerational churches but thriving churches move from being multigenerational to intergenerational through meaningful relationships across all generations. As we care for one another and learn from those who are younger and older, we are apprentices of each other and most of all, we are apprentices of Jesus.

There will be more to come in future editions of Trinity Times but for now, I want to invite you to consider doing one thing the next time you are at church – find someone in a different generation you do not know well and introduce yourself. Have a meaningful conversation with them. The first step of developing intergenerational relationships is to SEE one another. May God help us to SEE one another in this new year.
