Faithful Intergenerational Apprenticeship

Life has changed. (This could be the understatement of the year!)

No matter what age group you might find yourself in, you know the world is different than it was in the past. Whether you grew up in the '50s or '80s (decade with the best music) or '00s, most of us have a sense that the world has changed around us. Whether it is the types of technology or our cultural values, it seems life is ever-changing.

Let's face it. It is hard to stay up-to-date.

So, in the next several editions of The Trinity Times, I want to share a few nuggets of what it is like for most of today's young adults. Remember, I'm sharing general information from a 30,000 ft. view, rather than anecdotal cases that we all know to be different.

For most of today's young adults, life has slowed down. Even though the Millennials and Gen Z are the most connected generations and are exposed to adult type content at an earlier age, it is simply taking longer for many of them to reach adulthood based on the traditional mile markers (marriage, steady job, financial stability, living on their own, etc.).

Fifty years ago, most reached adulthood by the age of 23 or 24. Today, most sociologists and researchers would agree that today's young people do not reach adulthood until 29 or 30 years of age. Therefore, sociologists have labeled the third decade of life as emerging adulthood. It is often described as the most turbulent decade for today's young people.

So, what do we do with this information?

First, recognize that our young adults are experiencing a different life than you might have in your 20's.

Second, assume they are trying their best. They are not just lazy and entitled as the popular culture tries to label them. They are doing their best to navigate the uncharted waters.

Third, develop friendships with our young adults. Be curious about their lives. Seek them out when you are at church. Ask them what it's like to be a young adult today? Take a posture of listening and learning more than giving advice or providing answers.
