Dr. Jeffrey Arnett, Senior Research Scholar at Clark University in Worcester, Massachusetts, is the originator of the theory of emerging adulthood and extended adolescence. His research showed that there are five features of emerging adulthood:

- Age of identity exploration - Young adults are deciding who they are and what they want out of work, school, and love.
- Age of instability - The post-college years are marked by frequent moves and multiple job changes.
- Age of self-focus - In their 20's, young people are figuring out who they want to become, what career they want, and where they want to be in the future.
- Age of feeling in-between - Many emerging adults say they are taking responsibility for themselves, but still do not completely feel like an adult.
- Age of possibilities - Optimism reigns. Most emerging adults believe their best life is ahead of them.

Though the third decade of life can be filled with optimism, it can be hard to “launch” into adulthood, especially in Raleigh and the surrounding area. Nearly 56% of residents in the Triangle area hold a bachelor's degree, and more than 27% have a graduate degree. Embedded in the statistic is a large racial gap with white residents having a much larger share of the degrees compared to other races. This reflects the job market in which emerging adults are trying to find a stable career.

The result is that our young people are having to stay in school longer to compete in the marketplace. Staying in school also means that many are saddled with large amounts of student debt. The average student debt in North Carolina is just north of \$38,000. When the median salary of 25-34 year olds in the U.S. is only \$54,000 per year, you can see how financial stability is difficult to achieve as a young adult.

One more statistic to help better understand today's young adults – the average young adult experiences 8.4 different jobs in their 20s. Some of this is due to the nature of part-time jobs but this statistic speaks to the instability they face.

So what does all of this mean for us as a church family?

We should assume the best of our young adults. Let's recognize that our young adults are going through a period of ***instability within an unstable culture and economy***. Most are doing the best they can.

Let's provide them **relational support**. Get to know who they are and encourage them in life and in their faith journey.

Lastly, **pray for our young adults**. They need the CHURCH to be a place where they can BELONG.

When young adults are integral to the church, they help the church to be vibrant and full of life!
