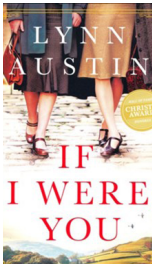

1950. In the wake of the war, Audrey Clarkson leaves her manor house in England for a fresh start in America with her young son. As a widowed war bride, Audrey needs the support of her American in-laws, whom she has never met. But she arrives to find that her longtime friend Eve Dawson has been impersonating her for the past four years. Unraveling this deception will force Audrey and Eve's secrets-and the complicated history of their friendship-to the surface.

1940. Eve and Audrey have been as different as two friends can be since the day they met at Wellingford Hall, where Eve's mother served as a lady's maid for Audrey's mother. As young women, those differences become a polarizing force . . . until a greater threat-Nazi invasion-reunites them. 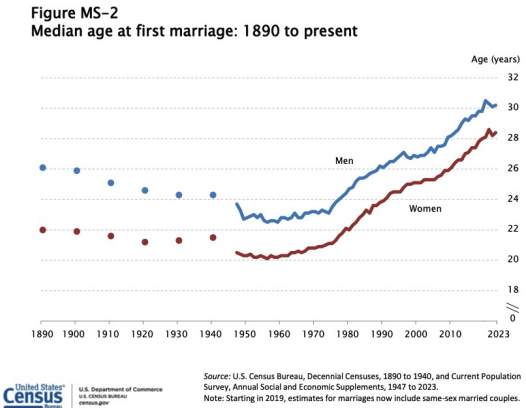

There is an old saying, “Love and marriage go together like horse and carriage.” This quote suggests that love and marriage are inseparable, much like a horse and carriage. It implies that love and marriage are intertwined and work best when they are together, much like the traditional image of a horse pulling a carriage.

Most young adults would not disagree with the quote. However, the problem for most young adults is that they are (on the average) finding love much later in life than in the past decades. If young people do not find a marriage partner while in college, many end up not getting married until much later in life.

In 1970, the median (50% before and 50% after) age of first marriage was 23 for men and 20 for women. Today, the median age has risen to slightly above 30 for men and 28 for women. According to new pew research, 25% of today’s 40 year olds in the US have never been married. What’s more, less young adults are even dating. Among 18-34-year-olds, over half [51%] say they don’t currently have a romantic relationship. That’s an increase of about 20% over the past 15 years.



In the past, the assumption in the church has always been that young adults will return to church when they get married and start a family together. What used to be just 3-5 years after graduating high school is now potentially 10-15 years. As you might imagine, there is a lot of life that happens during this time where young adults can really use the support of a loving faith community.

We can no longer assume that young adults will return to church after starting a family. The Church has to be a place where they can find love and support no matter their marital status or the number of children. We want to be a place where everyone can belong.

Let’s not make assumptions of one another but rather develop a deeper relationship with each other. Let’s encourage everyone to journey together. Let’s continue to SEE one another as brothers and sisters in Christ. We are ONE in Christ!
