FAITHFUL INTERGENERATIONAL APPRENTICESHIP Dr. Andy Jung

Over the last several years, there has been a steep increase in death by suicide on our university campuses in and around the Triangle. It is tragic to know that our college students feel they have nowhere to turn for help.

To address the heaviness of death and poor mental health our young people are experiencing, a group of moms and dads took it upon themselves to provide comfort and love to students on campus. A group of caring and empathetic adults decided to just show up on campus at NC State to give out free hugs and to be a listening ear to all students that came by.

In a <u>research</u> published by Harvard Graduate School of Education in October of 2023, thirty-six percent (36%) of young adults (ages 18-25) who responded to the survey reported experiencing anxiety and twenty-nine percent (29%) reported depression. The report identified 5 drivers of young adults' mental health challenges as:

- 1. A lack of meaning, purpose, and direction
- Financial worries and achievement pressure
- 3. A perception that the world in unraveling
- 4. Relationship deficits
- 5. Social and political issues

There is a mental health crisis among today's young adults. (This is likely the understatement of the year.) The young adults in our circle of influence are no different. They feel the same pressures, lack relational support and face difficult challenges from multiple directions.

So, what do we do?

First, we work to develop trust-filled relationships. Don't assume that just by knowing their names, you've built enough trust. Trust is only built over time. We have to consistently show up for (and with) young adults WITHOUT OUR OWN AGENDA. (This is true for our children and youth also.) We just keep showing up in their lives with love and empathy.

Second, when opportunities arise, help young people make meaning of what they are experiencing. Help them to know there is meaning and purpose in life. Help them to know they are more than the sum of their achievements. Let them know they are ENOUGH because of Jesus.

Lastly, Keep pointing them to Jesus. It is not our job to "fix" people. Our role is to model a hope-filled life and remind them of how much God and you love them. Our hope is found in Jesus.





Update from our Disaster Relief Team: Trinity Baptist Disaster Relief & FBC Hillsborough Collaboration

Recently, the Disaster Relief Team at Trinity was approached by Lydia Tatum, Welcome House Network Director and Johnny Glover to evaluate and possibly fix a leak in a bathroom of the First Baptist Church Welcome House in Hillsborough, NC.

Their Welcome House has hosted families for 3 years but had only 1 shower. Fixing the upstairs shower means they could host more families at a time.

Louis Pearce, Mark Blashaw and myself made an evaluation visit to develop a plan of action. We determined we could replace the shower pan, repair drain, and retile the area to stop the leak.

Mark Blashaw, Mark Munday, and Johnny Glover (someone was needed to hand tools) worked 5 days to complete the project. The first day we took out the old floor and of course discovered the floor was not level. Second day Mark and Mark replaced the floor to get ready for tiles. Mark Blashaw, and Johnny (mostly Mark) worked the last days laying the floor and tiles. The best part (because of donations) the cost was zero. We contacted Byrd Tile and he donated all the tiles and material.

After 5 days and 96 man hours, the Welcome House shower is now fixed and ready for refugees. Much thanks goes to Mark Blashaw who worked all 5 days and did most of the planning and labor.

Marriage Enrichment Groups


