This week is the week that we vote on our church budget for 2025. I am grateful for our Finance Committee and all other committees in the church that enable our process of forming a ministry budget each year. All our committee leaders, ministry leaders and ministers help our Finance Committee as we plan and propose a new budget for each year. Our process is to have requests made by various committees and ministries to the Finance Committee. The Finance Committee studies these requests as well as previous years reports to develop our best ministry budget. The budget is then prepared and presented to the Trustees for questions and approval. Once this process has taken place, the budget is sent to each of our church members for their information. During our October Church Conference, the budget plan is presented for questions and any amendments. If no amendment is made, the church votes in worship the following Sunday by ballot to approve the budget. I am grateful to be in a congregation where so many are able give input and help us arrive at a budget that can guide and support our various ministries.

I want to thank you as a congregation for your continued generosity toward our budget. If you are tithing and giving to our church, thank you. If you would like to begin giving, there are several ways you can give. You can give on Sunday mornings through the offering. The offering is taken each Sunday during the 10:55 a.m. service and we collect an offering in the receptacles in the Narthex during 8:45 a.m. worship. If you want offering envelopes, please contact the church office. You can also give online through the website at tbcraleigh.com. In addition, you can set up a bank draft (this is what Robin and I have used for many years, and it helps our giving be systematic and faithful) through our Financial Administrator Jan Brown.

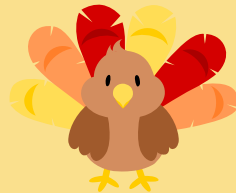

Young adults aren't merely "going through a phase." They exist in a developmental stage in which they have more capacity to reflect on who they are, focus more on investing in who they want to become, and navigate more choices on the road to adulthood—but they haven't arrived yet.

The young adults are encountering challenging, exciting, and disorienting experiences as they figure out life changes and make

choices to take responsibility for their lives and relationships. They long for meaningful community and connection. Are we ready to meet them in the ways they need us most?

Seeing young adults for who they are means recognizing the significant transitions that are happening in their lives.

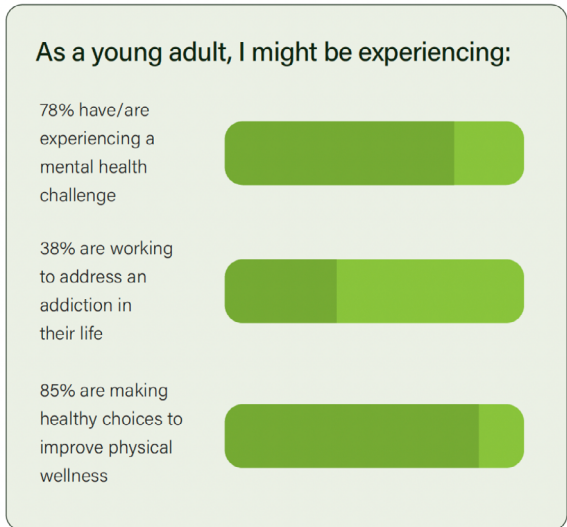
Over the last four editions of *Trinity Times*, we've talked about four different transitions young adults can experience in their 20s: self-identifying, relating, contributing, and taking responsibility. Another transition young adults can experience is self-caring.

Just because young adults are young doesn't mean they don't face health challenges. Young adults are trying to take care of themselves by making healthy choices to protect, improve, or recover their physical, emotional, and mental health. The added pressures of adulthood increase the need to actively tend to their own well-being. They are wondering how to maintain their health in the midst of pressures and other priorities in their lives.

Here are three questions you can ask young adults about self-care:

- When do you feel at your best mentally and physically?
- What does self-care look like for you these days?
- When is it easiest to take care of yourself? When is it a challenge?

Remember to listen with curiosity and empathy. Meet them where they are. Help them to know you care about them as a person, not for what they can do for you or for the church.
