
Baptist Women are asking for volunteers to bring in 3 dozen homemade cookies each, to the Christmas Party for a mission project to our homebound & other special servants.

## FAITHFUL INTERGENERATIONAL APPRENTICESHIP Dr. Andy Jung

If you've been following along, we've been going through the different transitions young adults face in their 20s. Throughout this fall, we've talked about needing to see young adults for who they are, where they are, and what they're searching for. Here are the ones we've covered:

- Self-Identifying: "I'm figuring out who I'm becoming, in all its complexity."
- Relating: "I'm learning who I can trust in light of my past, present, and future relationships."
- Contributing: "I'm discovering what I can contribute for the betterment of myself and others."
- Taking responsibility: "I'm figuring out how to bear more of the weight and direction of my life and relationships."
- 88% are experiencing meaningful connection with God 55% have doubted or questioned the religious teachings of their childhood 53% are seeking a spiritual or religious mentor to aid their personal growth 49% are searching for a faith community they can trust

As a young adult, I might be experiencing:

- Self-Caring: "I'm learning to care for myself now that my wellbeing is up to me."
- Acclimating: "I'm putting down shallow roots and trying to thrive where I am."

The final transition is:

• Meaning-Making: "I'm seeking to make sense of my life and connect my spirituality with a community."

Young adults are constructing views of the world that match the growing sense of who they are, where they fit in, and what their purpose is. Sometimes their religious views match the ones they've inherited from parents, mentors, or faith communities. However, sometimes they begin to think slightly differently and they wonder "Does my faith help me navigate all the changes I'm going through?"

Maybe, rather than telling young adults what they should believe in or how to think, we should lead with curiosity. Let's ask the following questions:

- What's currently changing in your views of God and the world?
- How are these changes impacting your connection to church?
