A note of a special Sunday - June 22, 2025

We're excited to continue a meaningful tradition here at Trinity! On Sunday, June 22, there will be no Preschool or Children's Sunday School. Here's what you need to know:

- If you attend the late service, come directly to the Fellowship Hall at 9:45 AM. You may drop your younger children off at Worship Care beginning at 10:45 AM, with plenty of time to get to worship.
- VBS Singers (Pre-K 5th Grade): Children who participated in VBS will sing in the 10:55 AM service. The VBS team will bring them to the Sanctuary at 10:30 AM to rehearse and get settled.



What is the Mission Project?
