## We also celebrate our Mission Project: Helping Our Neighbors in the Mountains

This year's VBS mission focus was close to home. We partnered with Asheville Buncombe Community Christian Ministry (ABCCM) to support recovery efforts in western North Carolina, where communities are still deeply impacted by the devastation of Hurricane Helene.

ABCCM has faithfully served their mountain community since 1969, but in the wake of this disaster, they are stretched thin—continuing critical ministries while helping neighbors rebuild, all while suffering significant loss themselves, including the flooding of their own storage facility.

So we stepped in to help—and what a response! Our goal was to raise \$3,000, and by God's grace and your generosity, we have already exceeded that goal, with a current total of \$3469.63! (Donations will continue to be accepted through July In addition to financial support, we also collected muchneeded items for ABCCM's Crisis and Jail Ministries. Thanks to your generosity, we were able to assemble care bags to send

to this vital ministry—bags filled with daily essentials to bless individuals reentering the community after incarceration. These small but powerful gifts will offer hope, dignity, and a reminder that they are not forgotten.

Thank you for a week filled with faith, friendship, and fun. Thank you for being part of something so special. As we wrap up an amazing week, we ask that you continue to pray for the children who were with us during VBS. Pray that the truths they heard will take root in their hearts, that they would know how deeply loved they are by God, and that they would continue to grow in faith long after this week is over.

Thank you for being part of what God is doing in the lives of these precious young ones!
